Coach Broering is in his 20th year of coaching, second at Northmont. Prior to his arrival, he spent five years as the Offensive Coordinator at Piqua High School, where in 2006, they won the Division II state championship.

Previously, Coach Broering was the Head Football coach at Springfield South where he worked from 1991-2005. In 2005, Coach Broering was selected to be the offensive coordinator in the Ohio vs Pennsylvania Big 33 All-Star Classic. Coach Broering has also coached in the MVFCA All-Star Game eight times and served as the winning Head Coach in 2001. Coach Broering has twice been selected by the MVFCA as the Assistant Coach of the Year, once offensively, one defensively.
